03 Changes relating to the Scheme

This section describes material changes to the Scheme's nature, investment objectives and strategy and management during the Accounting Period. Other material changes to the Scheme may have occurred since the end of the Accounting Period. Except as otherwise stated, these are not described here, but will be set out in next year's Annual Report.

Changes to the Governing Document

The Scheme's Governing Document was created on 5 July 2018 and was subsequently amended and restated on 5 December 2023 to reflect the re-naming of the Juno KiwiSaver Scheme to the Pie KiwiSaver Scheme (and the renaming of the 3 Funds within as Pie KiwiSaver Conservative Fund, Pie KiwiSaver Balanced Fund and Pie KiwiSaver Growth Fund).

Terms of offer of interests in the Scheme

During the Accounting Period the Product Disclosure Statement for the Scheme was updated on 5 December 2023 to reflect the re-naming of the Juno KiwiSaver Scheme to the Pie KiwiSaver Scheme (and the re-naming of the 3 Funds within as Pie KiwiSaver Conservative Fund, Pie KiwiSaver Balanced Fund and Pie KiwiSaver Growth Fund).

On 5 December 2023 we revised the fund description / investment strategy wording to reflect that, in addition to intra-scheme inter-funding (i.e. Pie KiwiSaver Conservative Fund investing into the Pie KiwiSaver Balanced Fund and the Pie KiwiSaver Balanced Fund investing into the Pie KiwiSaver Growth Fund), the Funds may invest in other funds outside the Scheme also managed by Pie Funds Management Limited (i.e. related inter-scheme inter-funding).

Changes to the Statement of Investment Policy and Objectives (SIPO)

During the Accounting Period the SIPO for the Scheme was updated on 31 July 2023 to reflect changes to the asset allocation upper limits for international fixed interest, NZ fixed interest and international equities for Balanced Fund and NZ fixed interest for the Pie KiwiSaver Growth Fund.

On 5 December 2023 the SIPO was amended to reflect the re-naming of the Juno KiwiSaver Scheme to the Pie KiwiSaver Scheme (and re-name the 3 Funds within as Pie KiwiSaver Conservative Fund, Pie KiwiSaver Balanced Fund and Pie KiwiSaver Growth Fund), and that, in addition to intra-scheme inter-funding (i.e. Conservative investing into Balanced and Balanced investing into Growth), the Funds may invest in other funds outside the Scheme also managed by Pie Funds (i.e. related inter-scheme inter-funding).

Related Party Transactions

During the accounting period the Funds started to invest in certain Funds within the Pie Funds Management Scheme, including the Pie Fixed Income Fund, Pie Property and Infrastructure Fund, Pie Australasian Growth 2 Fund, Pie Global Growth Fund and Pie Global Growth 2 Fund. All related party transactions were conducted on arm's length terms.
